Content

Supervised structured toxicology training activities

- A. Clinical attachment to HKPIC (5 days per week)
 - Daily morning case round
 - Follow toxicologist to see clinical consultation
 - Learn the skill of answering phone consultation
- B. Attend certificate course of clinical toxicology (10 sessions per year)
 - May sit in or join the yearly program
- C. Tutorial session (12 sessions per 6 months)
 - Systemic and comprehensive discussion on the important topics of clinical toxicology
- D. Biweekly case discussion session
 - Discussion on clinical case of poisoning
- E. Weekly Grand Round
 - Bedside teaching on poisoned patient
- F. Monthly journal discussion session
 - Discussion on the classical landmark or newly published important literatures on clinical toxicology
- G. Monthly research session
 - Conducting research under supervision and report the progress in the monthly research session
